UNDERSTAND THE TEST

Whether your client wishes to go red, blonde or darker, it is important to conduct an Allergy Alert Test in the salon 48 hours before her colour service. Performing this test is vital to safeguard you and your client against the risk of an unwelcome allergic reaction.

STEP ONE

Mix 5 grams colour (exact shade to be used if known) and 5 grams developer.



STEP TWO

Apply 1cm² of colour directly below the crook of the elbow.

STEP THREE

Leave the colour uncovered for 45 minutes. Then, rinse the area with lukewarm water and pat dry with a clean towel.

STEP FOUR

Ask the client to either come back to the salon after 48 hours or call you to inform you of the result.

TAKE IT FORWARD

You should now feel confident about performing an Allergy Alert Test.
